We would like to extend our gratitude to all those involved in ensuring the safe release of the hostages.

We will be working closely with the relevant authorities to conduct a thorough investigation into the events leading up to this incident. We are committed to addressing any underlying issues to prevent such incidents from occurring in the future and on doing everything possible to secure labour peace at the mine. Our focus over the past few days has been solely on securing the safe release of all our employees. We will now turn our attention to taking necessary action against those involved in the conduct of any unlawful and illegal activity.
